

GENERAL INFORMATION

In order to serve you better, please take a moment to read the following directions:

- REGISTRATIONS ARE TO BE MAILED TO:
The Appliqué Society, P. O. Box 21136,
Columbus, OH 43221-0136. Registrations will only be accepted by mail. In order to be pre-registered, your registration must be postmarked by April 20, 2007 to assure processing before the event. Any registrations postmarked after the deadline will not be processed or confirmed. However, registration will be available on site during regular show days and hours.
- Preference for registration of classes will be given to TAS members until Jan. 31, 2007. Forms received from non-members before that date will be held and processed after that date in the order in which they are received. After Feb. 1, 2007, all registration forms will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Please submit one registration form per person; you may copy the form for friends.
- Remember to indicate a second choice for classes.

PAYMENTS

Personal checks or Money Orders for US Funds payable to "The Appliqué Society" covering all fees must be included with registration, or payment may be made by Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express.

LIABILITY WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

On the Registration Form you will find the Liability Waiver and Indemnification Agreement. Your registration cannot be processed without your signature on the space indicated.

CANCELLATIONS, REFUNDS, BALANCE DUE

\$25 REGISTRATION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE. If you find that you are unable to attend this event or would like to change or drop any class, we must be notified in writing. A full refund of fees, minus the non-refundable registration fee, will be made if a written cancellation notice is postmarked no later than April 20, 2007, otherwise NO refunds will be made.

If original payment was made by check, refunds due to filled or cancelled classes will be returned with your confirmation. If there is a balance due, please pay this upon receipt of your confirmation. For payments made by credit card, the actual amount of class or event fees (after considering filled or cancelled events or other differences) will be charged to your credit card and you will be notified of the charges in your confirmation.

CONFIRMATIONS, CHANGES

Please allow up to four weeks for your registration to be processed. Your confirmation will show the classes (with supply lists) and events for which you have been registered. Any changes not made in writing by April 20, 2007 will have to be handled on-site during the Show. On-site class changes can be made, when availability allows, at the TAS Registration Desk.

When you check in at the Registration Desk at the Show, be sure to bring your confirmation form and your current TAS membership card.

SEWING MACHINES FOR CLASSES

You may bring your own machine or you may use a loaner provided by Janome and others. If you are registering for a class that requires a machine and you will not be bringing your own, please indicate this on the Registration Form so we will be able to assess the quantity of machines needed.

TEACHER'S HELPER

Each class will have a Teacher's Helper who will assist the teacher in any way. If you would like to be a Teacher's Helper, please indicate this on your Registration Form in the space provided. If you are the first to respond, you will be Teacher's Helper and will be notified in your confirmation. You must be registered in the class for which you volunteer.

VOLUNTEERS

The Appliqué Society's quilt shows cannot operate without volunteers. TAS quilt shows are managed by people who put in countless hours to bring you an outstanding display of the art of appliqué. Volunteers are needed for white glove hosts, admissions and other areas during the Show. Please volunteer some of your time by indicating so on the Registration Form, or if you find you have some free time during the Show, you may check with the Volunteer Desk.

We appreciate the work of all our volunteers. Our Show Chair Persons can be identified by their name badge. Please take time when you see one of them to express appreciation of all their hard work. And if you need assistance during the Show, please feel free to ask any of them, they will either have an answer for you or find someone who does.

QUILT SHOW ADMISSION

All those who have pre-registered will be admitted to the Show without charge. Any TAS member may attend the Show for free by showing their current TAS membership card. All others will be charged admission of \$5.00 per day (\$4.00 for children under 12 and seniors over 60).
